- General equipment like Infusion devices, sterilizers, hospital beds, etc.
- Physical therapy equipment
- Physiological instruments and monitoring equipment
- Telemetry systems and medical equipment network
- Clinical instrumentation
- Imaging systems like ultrasound and contrast injectors
- Respiratory equipment
