

# START/EDIT PROFILE



Go through the profile pages and enter your personal information.



- Pg. 8 - High School Information, use the search bar to find your high school, once selected it will show up where it says "your school"
  - Home school students, can search "Home Schooled" and then enter in location information for your home
  - Enter your approximate Graduate Date ex. 05/25/2023, 05/25/2024, 05/25/2025
  - If your school does not appear in the list use the "School not found" option and enter your school name and location.
  - GED: will always be "no" while you are a dual credit student


## PROFILE TIPS:

- Pg. 9 – No, you’ve never taken college classes unless you’ve taken dual credit at another highschool (not including dual credit through Collin College).
- Pg. 10 – Question about how long you’ve lived in Texas: By the time you graduate high school, will you have lived in Texas during 10th, 11th, and 12th grade?
  - If you answer yes, you’ll only see two additional questions.
  - If you answer no, you will see additional questions about parent/legal guardian.
