Collin College employs native or near-native ASL language models who mentor, assist, and tutor ASL and Interpreting students one-on-one or in small groups in an immersive setting. ASL Laboratory staff seek to support students' language learning, develop culturally appropriate norms, and enhance ASL and interpreting skills and tasks designated by the student's instructors.

The ASL Laboratory is located at the Plano Campus in Room BB-108. Hours of operation are posted outside the lab each semester.
