EBSCO Learning Express offers TSI preparation practice exams for the ELAR, Essay and Math assessments. This is done on their site by creating a free account. This guide will show you how to access the resources.

*This guide is for students who have a valid CWID and access to [CougarWeb](#). If you do not, use may use your Library card obtained from your choice of Public library when creating an account at [Learning express hub](#).

Step 1: Click on the [Library](#) tab on the top left.

Step 3: Click LearningExpress Library. You can search under “L” to get to link faster.
