

## What about the Essay Portion?

- Have an introduction with a thesis
- Argue your thesis with 3 supporting paragraphs
- Finish your essay with a conclusion
- Reread your essay and edit for capitalization, punctuation, and spelling

- Try and analyze the literature to understand its meaning.
- Learn to draw conclusions based on the information given.
- Try to understand the author's intent through the main ideas stated.
